



Uniform and Dress Code Guidelines

Students in Kindergarten through eighth grade will wear clothing meeting the guidelines established by the School Administrator as listed below. Students who don't comply with these guidelines may be asked to change into clothing kept in the office, or they may call their parent or guardian to bring appropriate attire to school.

General Guidelines:

- Uniform colors (short or long sleeves) tops are as follows: Solid white, true red, dark navy, hunter green, light blue or light pink.
- Shoes: Daily wear and gym shoes must have non-marking soles and heels. No backless shoes or sandals may be worn. Shoelaces must be tied at all times. Students will not be permitted to wear boots of any kind indoors during school hours.
- Solid socks, tights or leggings must be worn at all times. They all must be white, true red, dark navy, hunter green, light blue, light pink, gray or black. No labels, tags or emblems are permitted
- Excessive make-up or jewelry is inappropriate. Only pierced ears are allowed.
- Hair must be worn above eyebrows. Hair may not hang in students eyes. Inappropriate hair colors or styles are not permitted.
- Uniform shorts/capris may be worn Apr.1 – Nov. 30 only.
- The length of jumpers, skirts, skorts, and shorts must be no shorter than four inches above the top of the knee.
- All clothing must be neat and clean without rips or tears.
- Layering of clothing is allowed. The under layer must be in the appropriate uniform colors and tucked in at all times. Camisoles are considered undergarments and should not be seen.

Non-Uniform Days:

On special event days when uniforms are not worn, clothing should be clean, modest, neat, and free of rips or tears. Short length and modesty guidelines must be followed. Blue jeans are allowed unless specifically stated otherwise. Scout uniforms and sport jerseys may be worn the day of the meeting or activity. Boots of any kind may not be worn indoors.

Girls

Tops- Blouses (plain white, long or short sleeve) must be tucked in. Polo shirts, sweaters, sweater vests, or turtle necks must be solid white, true red, dark navy, hunter green, light blue, or light pink with no labels, tags or emblems.

Bottoms- Pants, shorts, capris, and leggings in uniform colors, navy blue or tan khaki may be worn. Leggings may only be worn with shorts or skirts over them. No extra pockets, zippers, flaps, loops, labels, tags or emblems are permitted. Leggings must be ankle length (no capris length). Leggings must be solid with no design, mesh, straps or other design. The length of jumpers, skirts, shorts, and shorts must be no shorter than four inches above the top of the knee.

Skirts/skorts/jumpers- Must be navy or tan Khaki or the approved plaid.

Boys

Tops- Polo shirts, sweater vests, or turtle necks must be short or long sleeves in solid white, true red, dark navy, hunter green, light blue, or light pink (short or long sleeve) without labels, tags, or emblems.

Bottoms- Uniform style pants and shorts that are navy blue or tan khaki can be worn. No extra pockets, zippers flaps, loops, labels, tags or emblems are permitted.

Sweatshirts

Beginning 2018-19 hooded sweatshirts can only be worn on Spirit Days. Hoodies and additional spirit wear may be purchased at different times throughout the year at the school office. Sales forms will indicate if the item is uniform approved. A uniform polo must be worn with sweatshirts.

Approved Plaid

The following plaids are acceptable. They are shown with their and their Lands End name. Previously approved plaids may continue to be worn.

Uniforms

GENERAL

No emblems, no extra pockets or loops, solid colors, no boots.

Top Colors: White

True Red

Navy

Hunter Green

Light Blue

Light Pink

Bottom Colors: Tan/Khaki

Approved Plaid:



Available for purchase at uniform retailers. Lands End refers to the pattern as Hunter/Classic Navy Plaid. It is also available at other uniform retailers.

BOYS

Tops: Polo, long-sleeve polo or sweater with plain white shirt.

Bottoms: Uniform style pants or uniform shorts can be worn April 1-November 30.

GIRLS

Tops: Plain white blouses, polo, long-sleeve polo, sweaters or sweater vests.

Bottoms: No shorter than four inches above the knee.

Uniform style pants, capris, jumpers, skirts, skorts and shorts. Leggings may be worn with skirts, plain and uniform colored, full length.

UNISEX

Socks: Solid socks, tights or leggings must be worn at all times. They all must be white, true red, dark navy, hunter green, light blue, light pink, gray or black. No labels, tags or emblems are permitted.

Spirit Day Fridays: SJB logoed tops can be worn with uniform bottoms.
